Assignment Name: What type of employee are you and how do others influence your work habits?

Read the situation below related to the Employability Skills Area. Work Habits. Type a 150-word (minimum) response to this situation and make sure you answer the three questions in your response.

Situation:

You work in an environment with employees of all ages (17-65). You observe how other people in your department work and determine what path you will follow. Some employees are always on time to work, work without supervision, take a proactive approach in their assignments and have a good attitude. Other employees choose to report to work late, wait on someone to tell them what to do, react when asked to complete a task and don't have a positive attitude. The third group of employees remain indifferent to either of the other types of employees previously mentioned.
